You have Careers lessons in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to help you think about your skills and abilities and the sort of jobs and courses you can do in the future. If you go into the 6th form these lessons will continue.

You will learn how to find out about jobs and courses by using careers information in the Careers Library and on the computer – this will help you if you do not know what you would like to do.

From Year 9 you will have the opportunity to do activities and events linked to jobs and in Year 11 and 13 you will get the opportunity to do work experience so you can try out different job ideas before making a decision.

You are also entitled to support from a Choices Adviser from the local Careers service, Prospects, in Year 9 who will meet with you to talk about your interests and ideas and start your Career Plan.

The Choices Adviser will attend your Year 9 and the year you are leaving Annual Review and discuss with you and your parents/carers the courses and jobs open to you when you leave school. They will keep in touch with you until you leave school and afterwards if needed.
